Net4Society is the network of National Contact Points (NCPs) for Societal Challenge 6 “Europe in a Changing World: Inclusive, Innovative and Reflective Societies” (SC6) which is a part of the third pillar of **Horizon 2020**, the European funding programme for Research and Innovation.

National Contact Points are officially nominated by their national authorities and their role is to advise you on all aspects of Horizon 2020 **funding opportunities** and help you cross borders with your research ideas.

Societal Challenge 6 More than research...taking Socio-economic Sciences and Humanities further.

Established as a network in 2008, Net4Society connects all NCPs, the EU Commission, researchers and other relevant stakeholders within the field of **Socio-economic Sciences and Humanities (SSH)**.

Since the start of Horizon 2020, Net4Society has expanded its field to include ICT, Digital Sciences, International Cooperation, e-Government, Open Science and New Forms of Innovation.
